



'Barcelona, forever' Photography Contest Guidelines

Entrants

Anyone over the age of 18 may enter the contest by submitting photographs of the city of Barcelona. Each entrant may send a maximum of 2 photographs.

Submission period

Entries will be received between 16 November 2009 and 29 January 2010. All photographs must be sent through the Núñez i Navarro Hotels Facebook page (<http://www.facebook.com/nnhotels.barcelona>).

Photograph guidelines

Only digital photographs will be accepted. All images must be original works and the exclusive property of the entrant, and must not have won any previous contests or been published elsewhere.

Entrants must agree to send the original photographs if requested by Núñez i Navarro Hotels.

Photographs will be disqualified if:

- they are offensive or pornographic.
- they are photographic montages.
- they document illegal behavior or condone any kind of criminal conduct.

Prizes

1. The first-place winner will receive a free two-night stay and breakfast at Hotel U232, redeemable between 1 February and 31 March 2010 (subject to availability).
2. The second-place winner will receive an exclusive dinner for two at the Hotel 1898 restaurant, redeemable between 1 February and 31 March 2010 (with prior reservation).

Prizes are non-transferable and may not be exchanged for any other goods or services.

Publication of prize-winners

Winners will be contacted directly through their Facebook page, and their names will be published on the Núñez i Navarro Hotels website as well as the blogs Experiencias NN and NN Experiences.



Judges

Entries will be judged by friends and fans of Núñez i Navarro Hotels. The winning entries will be those which have received the most positive votes (I like) upon the close of the submission period.

Copyright

Núñez i Navarro Hotels assumes all rights to reproduction, distribution, communication and transformation, remuneration, private copying, collections or complete works, and participation relative to the winning photographs.

Contest entrants cede these rights strictly and absolutely in the public domain and in any country worldwide, and must agree to renounce any other remuneration offered for the use of the work. The winning entrants retain moral rights to their work.

Authorship and legal stipulations

The submission of any entry will imply the presentation of original work, with the consequences of the assignment of rights as indicated in the contest guidelines. Any complaint related to the originality of submitted works will be the responsibility of the corresponding entrant. To such effect, Núñez i Navarro Hotels assumes the right to take action against any entrant if the authorship of his or her work is disputed. In cases where authorship of entries has been disputed, Núñez i Navarro Hotels assumes the right to transfer any and all materials received, and to claim damages incurred.

Right to Privacy

All photographs must respect the right to privacy and personal images in accordance with the stipulations of Organic Law 1/1982, of 5 May, regarding the civil protection of the right to honor, personal and family privacy, and an individual's own image. Contest entrants who submit photographs pledge to have the expressed consent of any and all whose rights to honor, personal and family privacy, and one's own image may be affected.

In accordance with Organic Law 15/1999, of 13 December, regarding the protection of personal data, all data provided by contest entrants will be incorporated in an automated database owned by Núñez i Navarro Hotels, with the sole purpose of managing the 'Barcelona, forever' photograph contest. Personal data provided will not be transferred to any other entity without the prior consent of the participant.

All contest participants who submit their work must expressly consent to the handling of their data for the purposes indicated.
